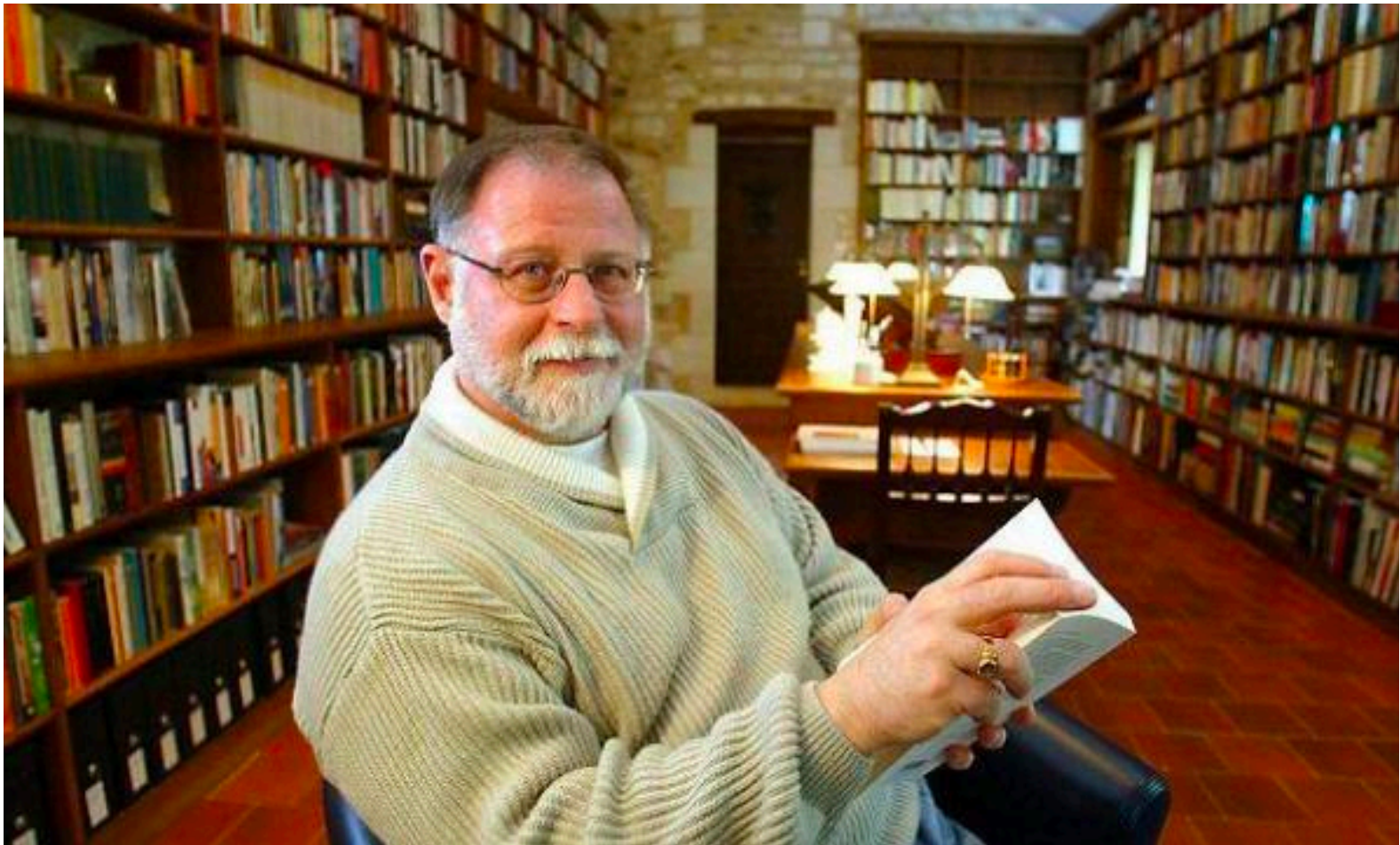

Currently the Director of La Biblioteca Nacional in Argentina, Manguel has won acclaim worldwide as an author, translator, anthologist, and editor. Through novels, non-fiction, essays, and columns, he has explored a range of topics from film criticism to fantasy to LGBTQ\* studies. As Director of La Biblioteca Nacional, he curates Argentina's national memory and cultural heritage through the preservation, collection, and dissemination of texts foundational to Argentine identity.
